System Requirements

- Processor:** Intel-based CPU (486 or later)
 - RAM:** 32MB for test mode; at least 96MB for graphics mode with KDE; 128MB recommended for graphics mode with office applications
 - Graphics card:** Standard VGA-compatible
 - Pointer:** Serial, PS/2, or IBM PS/2-compatible USB mouse
- The 3D-accelerated desktop and other features may require additional RAM.

DVD Boot

Place this DVD in the drive and restart your system. If your computer doesn't start, make sure your BIOS is configured to boot from a DVD. Enter the BIOS setup menu (see your vendor documentation), make sure DVD boot is enabled, and make sure the DVD drive is before the hard drive in the boot order.
